3. This event is subject to cancellation should the minimum number is not reached.
4. Full payment must be made directly to the Instructor upon confirmation of your enrolment.
5. The instructor has the discretion to accept late enrolments after the closing deadline as it sees fit.
6. Unless the activity is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, low enrolment or bad weather, no refund for withdrawal will be entertained after the enrolment has been processed.
7. Bad weather arrangement: The activity will be cancelled if typhoon signal no. 8 or above / Black Rainstorm Warning is hoisted 2 hours prior to the commencement of the course.
